#### THEIR STORY

Julio was born in Guerrero, and raised with his 2 siblings. He arrived in Ensenada when he was a child because his parents were looking for job opportunities. He was able to have an education up to high school. He met his partner at the age of 18, with whom he has two children. He works in the field and has a salary of 1800 Mexican pesos a week. He is not Christian.

Miriam was born in Ensenada, raised in home with her parents and 3 siblings. They worked in the field, always working hard. She was able to have her studies up to middle school but then she had to work to help with home expenses. When she was 21, she met Julio, whom she married. She is now a mother of 2 daughters. She is a housewife.

They have been together for 12 years. They lived many years in the house of Miriam's parents, but have been living on their land for 2 years. This family works in the field. The land in which they are currently living on, was given to them by Miriam's father. They have not been able to build anything of their own because their income isn't enough, this is why they requested Pastor Carlos Mora's support. Julio works at a local farm nearby. Miriam sometimes works in the field, but it's difficult given that she has to take care of their daughters. Their house is very deteriorated, there are water leaks and it gets very cold in winter time.

#### SPIRITUAL LIFE

They have recently started attending church, but do not attend frequently. The pastor knows the family from many years ago, since they are people from the community.





### Their Community

The Garcia Maldonado family is currently living in a small rural community called Uruapan, south of Ensenada. This area of the city is home to thousands of migrant families, who came from southern states of Mexico, looking for better opportunities. Many 'colonias' don't have the most basic services, such as running water, electricity, and sewage systems. However, these areas are often the ones that offer the lowest prices to acquire a piece of land, and for that reason many families will buy in those areas despite the lack of services. For these families, the most common job opportunity is as a field laborer, providing workers the equivalent of about 65 dollars per week. These factors combined create a challenging environment for families to grow and create a safe space to call home.
